Telescopic Gates

SG-TG-002

A telescopic gate has the advantage that it takes up less space compared to a tracked or cantilevered sliding gate when in the open position. This therefore makes it ideal for a site where space is restricted either side of an entrance, but where the entrance itself is relatively wide - a single telescopic gate can be used for an opening of up to 14m, and a pair of gates for an opening of twice that size.



The final specification will take account of factors such as the level of security required and most suitable access control system, as well as aesthetics (e.g. complementing the adjacent fence design and adding company logos) - all of which we are able to do.
