Log Walling forms a visually attractive yet effective barrier and is often used in parks and around play areas, where it blends well with other landscape features and planting. Log walls are formed from timbers between 75 and 150mm diameter, and are set in a concrete filled trench to ensure a strong and durable barrier is created. Log Walling can be used both as a barrier and retaining wall, and is suitable for a wide mix of leisure applications.
